


# Fire Prevention

## FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

During 2010 there were 280 fire investigations with the following results:

- 26 found to be intentional
- 220 found to be unintentional
- 3 found to be unintentional by child
- 9 were undetermined
- 17 caused by equipment failure
- 5 other (mutual aid or exposures)

Our Quick Response Service attended to 269 patients.

During 2010 there was \$6.8 million worth of property at risk due to fire.

Only \$587,100 worth of property was lost.

Ninety-one percent of the property involved was saved.
