ICE

ICE, In Case of Emergency, is a simple way to make sure emergency contact and critical information is located in the event of an emergency.

In Case of an Emergency if the injured person(s) is unable to communicate, ICE allows first responders to easily and quickly find the injured person's emergency contact and/or critical medical information.

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Do you know what ICE is? Aside from the obvious frozen water variety or the slang term for diamonds, ICE is an important piece of your personal EMER-



GENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN. ICE stands for IN CASE OF EMERGENCY and refers to who you want contacted if you are involved in an emergency incident and unable to speak for yourself. Most of us have cell phones with us at all times, and your cell phone can aid emergency workers by providing them with a phone number for your emergency contact person. Simply program your phone using the name ICE and list the numbers of you designated emergency contact. Rescue workers and ER personnel are trained to check the phone for an ICE designation if you are unable to provide that information yourself.

It only takes a few minutes to do but it might save valuable hours tracking down your loved ones if you ever have a medical emergency.

To program your phone - enter 1ICE (+name of your contact) The number one before the word ICE puts it first in your directory - it also allows you to enter a second ICE contact by using the number 2 in front of ICE. Then add all the phone numbers for that person; home, work and cell phone.

It's that easy!
