Removal - The tree(s) to be removed are dead, diseased and/or damaged and must be removed to protect the public safety. Stumps are to be removed a minimum of eighteen (18) inches below ground and the hole filled in with topsoil. If no replanting is to occur, stump may be ground to a depth of four (4) inches. The tree service shall be responsible for the stump grinding.

Planting – Newly planted trees shall conform to the requirements of Article 554 of the Codified Ordinance of the City of Easton.

In granting this permit, it is made a condition that the Grantee, will in the performance of any work done by his/her agents or employees under this permit, be responsible at all times for any damage or loss to the property of the City of Easton or any damage or loss to the property of private owners. Also, that he/she will keep the sidewalks and streets clear from dirt and rubbish as may accumulate, will remove the same each day and have any obstruction properly lighted at night. Before obstructing the sidewalk or street in any way, permission must be obtained from the City of Easton to do so.
