## **Heil Pool**

## **Pool Rules and Regulations**

Persons visiting the Easton Pools are required to observe and abide by the following rules for the safety and enjoyment of all patrons:

### **Admission:**

- Season Pass Holders must have their current ID with them each time they enter the pool.
- Any person entering the facility, whether they intend to swim or not and no matter what time they enter, must pay daily admission or present their season pass.
- Receipt forms for season passes are not acceptable forms of identification. There is a \$5.00 fee for lost or damaged cards.
- All day care centers / organizations must have 2 (two) adults with every 8 (eight) children.
- No more than 10 (ten) total people from a day care organization may enter using one pass.

### **General Pool Rules**

- Children 12 years of age and under shall not use the pool unless accompanied by a responsible adult (19+) or parent/guardian.

- Persons with stomach infections or open wounds are not permitted in pool.
- No glass, food, drink or candy on pool decks.
- No running or rough play.
- No diving.
- No smoking.
- No littering.
- No inflatable flotation devices in pool.
- No refunds in inclement weather.
- Proper swimsuits must be worn. Cutoffs, jeans, etc. are not permitted in the pool.
- If inclement weather develops, there will be an hour waiting period before an announcement is made regarding closing.
- Swimming is not permitted in the slide area.
- Swimmers using the slides must possess a strong swimming ability. Swimmers in question may be asked to pass a deep-water test in order to be permitted on the slides. The lifeguard on duty has the authority to restrict any person on the slides who does not pass the deep-water test.
- Conduct that interferes with the enjoyment of others is prohibited.
- Patrons must report ALL injuries on city property to the pool manager. Patrons must complete accident reports.
